## ARRIVING FROM FIUMICINO AIRPORT

### BY TAXI

A one-way ride to Piazza Barberini costs approximately € 50.00

*Radiotaxi +39 06 3570*

Taxi service is available at arrival areas of Terminal 1 and Terminal 3.

Authorized Taxi vehicles are white with a TAXI sign on the roof. The symbol of the municipality of reference is fixed to the front doors and the license number is on the doors, on the back and inside the vehicle.

### BY TRAIN

The railway station is located inside the airport area, close to the arrival and departure terminals.

You can reach the city centre using the following *Trenitalia* connections:

**LEONARDO EXPRESS** a non-stop service dedicated exclusively to airport passengers from/to TERMINI Station with departures every 15 minutes and travel time of approximately 32 minutes.
